Henry M. Kelly Fatally Stricken

Henry M. Kelly, father of Gov. Harry F. Kelly, died at 1 a. m. today in the family residence, at 2465 Chicago Blvd., after an illness of 24 hours. He was 82.

Mr. Kelly, senior partner of the law firm of Kelly, Kelly and Kelly, was a native of Ottawa, LaSalle Illinois, and came to Detroit with his family in 1921.

All members of the family were at the bedside when he died. The governor came to Detroit immediately upon notification that his father had been stricken at 4 a. m. yesterday.

Other members of the family are the wife, the former Mollie ~~Mormey~~, whom he married 51 years ago in Ottawa; sons and daughters, Mrs. Charles Singler, Emmett J., Kathryn, Mrs. Leon Walsh, Lawrence E., Walter J. and Jerome B. Kelly, all of Detroit. He is survived also by two sisters, Mrs. David Finnegan and Mrs. John Golden of Chicago, and 20 grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted Monday at the residence and in Visitation Church. The time will be announced later.

Mr. Kelly has been active in his office affairs Wednesday and the attack came without forwarning.

Mr. Kelly was a past faithful navigator of the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus.
