

## H. M. Kelly.

Henry M. Kelly was born in Ottawa in 1865. He received his education in the public and high schools of Ottawa, and, in 1885, went with his parents to Indiana, where he remained on a farm three years. In 1888 he returned to Ottawa, and in the spring of 1889 commenced the study of the law with G. W. W. Blake, at that time State's Attorney of the county. Mr. Kelly was admitted to the bar March 18, 1891, and for two years and a half was assistant State's Attorney. He then was in partnership with Mr. Blake for some time, since which time he has practiced alone.
