Barton Kelly

Coggswells Ill Ind Batty

I was mustered into the United States Service January 25<sup>th</sup> 1864 at Springfield Ill. I received \$75.<sup>00</sup> bounty and was sent to Camp Butler at Springfield, Ill. On or about Feby 1<sup>st</sup> 1864 I left Camp with a squad of recruits to form my Battery. I left the squad the same day at Indianapolis Ind without permission Oct 2<sup>nd</sup> 1864 I enlisted in the 22<sup>nd</sup> Regt N.Y. Cav. at East-Tray N.Y. I received \$200. bounty and was sent to Hart's Island NY Harbor, Oct 5<sup>th</sup> 1864 I gave myself up as a member of Coggswells Battery to the Provost-Marshal at Hart's Island I was committed by him to prison and forwarded to this prison. I gave the Provost-Marshal the bounty I received at Tray N.Y. and told him to send it to the proper officers
