- 11-8-17: Commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant of Infantry. Given on the 8th day of November, 1917, conferring rank of Second Lieutenant in the Infantry from the 22nd day of December, 1917.
- 11-27-17: Special Order No. 83 ordering Harry F. Kelly to act as duty and to proceed to Hoboken, N.J., to report to the Commanding General at the port of embarkation on December 10, 1917, for transportation to France. Issued November 27, 1917
- 5-2-18: Citation-Order No. 1186 dated the 2nd day of May, 1918, and signed by Hinchay for Croix de guerre with palm, Croix de guerre with palm awarded by the French Government at the time of the citat
- 12---18: Special Order No. 284-0 from the War Department signed by Payton C. Marsh, being the special order honorably discharging 2nd Lieut. Harry F. Kelly from the Infantry, received by the Adjutant General's Office at Walter Reed Hospital on December of 1918.
- 12-7-18: Honorable discharge of the Army of the United States dated the 7th day of December, 1918, signed by I. Erwin, Adjutant General.
